- Team is responsible for your own food and beverages
- Prizes: Biggest fish, (team prize) most fish in the boat, smallest fish!
- Only **80** spots available! Book now!
- Lunch can be purchased at the Top Water Grill after tournament.
- **PARTICIPANTS: You must stay a minimum of two nights at the Resort to participate at no cost - or you can pay \$100.00 per person if you are not staying at the hotel for two nights.** (We will get a bi-weekly update on reservations and if you have not made room reservations by May 21<sup>st</sup>, but have a fishing spot reserved you will be removed from the tournament list)

**\*\*All participants must provide their own Texas Game fishing license. They will be checked by the boat captain before departure.\*\***
